As if Stafford County didn't offer enough on its own, there are plenty of very special, very unique cities and towns close just outside our borders. They offer even more experiences tourists won't find anywhere else in Northern Virginia (NoVa) or, frankly, anywhere in the country. We encourage you to check them out.

City of Alexandria

Named a Top 5 Best Small City in the U.S. by Conde Nast Traveler and one of the South's Prettiest Cities by Southern Living (among many, many other awards) Alexandria, VA hums with a cosmo feel and walkable lifestyle. "Old Town" Alexandria isn't just gorgeous, it's home to more than 200 independent restaurants and boutiques.

Arlington County

Looking for convenience and value near the nation's capital? Arlington sits just across the Potomac River from D.C. and is full of lively neighborhoods, American treasures, car-free fun and tons of dining and shopping. And you can choose from more than 40 hotels with rates averaging 20% lower than downtown D.C.

City of Fredericksburg

Sitting on the falls of the Rappahannock River, Fredericksburg is an ideal spot for history lovers. It has become a vital stop for myriad Civil War history tours. Today's Fredericksburg has preserved its memories well. It's large downtown historic district is dotted with Colonial structures and reminders of those who lived, worked, and fought here, while a National Park interprets the battles, and the city still shows its glories and its scars.

Fairfax County

Situated in the heart of Northern Virginia, Fairfax County draws visitors from all over the world seeking to explore its unique visitor experiences that you won't find anywhere else. From history to arts to museums and more, these one-of-a-kind attractions will delight the whole family. Fairfax is home to America's most visited historic estate, George Washington's Mount Vernon.

Fauquier County

Steeped in equestrian tradition, and surrounded by wineries and vineyards, today Fauquier County is known for its horse farms, wineries, and beautiful rolling land at the foot of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Dating back to the 17th century and the beginnings of our country, the area was listed in 1608 as part of the Northern Neck of the Colony of Virginia by Captain John Smith, explorer and leader of the Jamestown Colony.

King George County

Explore the natural beauty of this historic county. Enjoy a variety of water sports including kayaking, canoeing, jet and water skiing, paddle boarding, boating, fishing, crabbing or just sunbathing on the historic Rappahannock and Potomac rivers. Watch eagles soar at Caledon, hike, jog or cycle on the 15 mile Heritage Railroad.

Loudoun County

Loudoun, VA is an exquisite culinary and heritage destination just 25 miles from Washington, D.C. boasting more than 40 award-winning wineries and tasting rooms, 25+ craft breweries, as well as farm-to-table dining, country inns, bed and breakfasts, and more! Experience scenic vistas, deep American heritage, and charming small towns such as Leesburg and Middleburg, the capital of Virginia horse country.

Prince William County

Nestled 30 miles from D.C., Prince William, VA gives visitors the opportunity to be close to D.C., yet enjoy major attractions such as Jiffy Lube Live, Manassas National Battlefield Park, the National Museum of the Marine Corps, and shopping favorites. It also boasts the largest collection of trails, open space, and parks in Northern Virginia and is ideal for the outdoor adventure enthusiast.

Midway between Washington, D.C. and Richmond, VA, Spotsylvania is a picturesque county known for being as unique as its name. 



YOU SEE A RIVER, THEY SAW HOPE.



Tour through the Stafford region with a walking and driving tour of the historical sites that played a major role in thousands of enslaved persons' paths to freedom. Halfway between Richmond and Washington, D.C. sits a trail that was once used by freedom seeking men, women, and children during the summer of 1862. The **Trail to Freedom** provides an opportunity to see the region that witnessed over 10,000 of the enslaved escape and claim freedom. These brave families traveled thousands of miles on foot, by wagon, and rail through Stafford County, Virginia. Take the driving or walking tour and see where self-emancipating freedom seekers bravely crossed the river, traveled through Stafford's Aquia Landing, and then on to contraband camps in Washington, D.C.

HISTORY

Pop quiz: Where did George Washington grow up?

It's true. The father of our country was raised right here in southern Stafford County. How cool is that? The roots of American history course through Stafford, Virginia. Captain John Smith sailed up the Potomac from Jamestown in 1608, over 212,000 union soldiers camped here during the Civil War, and 10,000 enslaved persons self-emancipated through Aquia Landing in the spring of 1862. All of this, and so much more happened in Stafford County. If you're into history, you just have to get to Stafford County.

STAFFORD CIVIL WAR PARK

Aquia Episcopal Church

2938 Richmond Highway, Stafford, VA 22555

This Church was built around 1751-1757, and is one of the finest examples of colonial church architecture in Virginia.

Aquia Landing Park

2846 Brooke Road, Stafford, VA 22554

Open year-round, this popular public beach offers fishing, picnicking, kayaking and two large picnic shelters for rent.

Bethlehem Primitive Baptist Church

135 Chapel Green Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405

First organized in 1868 by Rev. York Johnson, an ex-slave, and 27 other members from White Oak Primitive Baptist Church. Rev. Johnson, assisted by the Freedmen's Bureau, established a benevolent organization called "The Union Branch of the True Vine" and founded the Union Branch School. Bethlehem Primitive Baptist Church is a County, State and National Historical Site, and contains historical graves from the late 1800s.

**STAFFORD ARMED
SERVICES MEMORIAL**



Chatham Manor

120 Chatham Lane, Fredericksburg, VA 22405

Owned by gentry, sustained by slaves, and witness to war, this Georgian-style mansion is best known for its role in the Civil War, when it served as Union headquarters during the Battle of Fredericksburg. It now serves as the headquarters of the Fredericksburg/Spotsylvania National Military Park Headquarters.



Civil War Trails

Stand in the footsteps of soldiers, civilians, and freedom seekers when you visit Stafford's 8 Civil War Trails sites. Our open air museum is ready and waiting for you. Follow Civil War Trails and create some history of your own.



Ellwood Manor

36380 Constitution Highway, Locust Grove, VA 22508

The 1790s house on the Wilderness Battlefield served as a hospital and headquarters at different times. Location of Stonewall Jackson's arm burial site.



Fredericksburg & Spotsylvania National Military Park

120 Chatham Lane, Falmouth, VA 22405

In 1927 the U.S. Congress established Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania County Memorial National Military Park to commemorate the heroic deeds of the men engaged at the battles of Fredericksburg, Chancellorsville, Wilderness, and Spotsylvania Court House.

George Washington's Ferry Farm

268 King's Highway, Fredericksburg, VA 22405

Visit the home where George Washington grew up and lived from age 6 to 22. His family moved to a farm in Stafford called the "Home Farm" but later became known as Ferry Farm because people crossed the Rappahannock River on a ferry from the farm to the town of Fredericksburg. Take an interactive guided tour of Washington's interpretive replica house.



Hartwood Church

50 Hartwood Church Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22406

Echoes of history are found within the walls of this historic Presbyterian Church which was occupied and vandalized by Union troops during the Civil War. Today the walls are new but the building is listed on the Virginia Landmarks Register and National Register of Historic Places for its place in history, and is listed as a site on the Civil War Trail.



Historic Kenmore

1201 Washington Avenue, Fredericksburg, VA 22401

Built by patriot Fielding Lewis and his wife, Betty (the sister of George Washington), the house contains some of the most elaborate plasterwork from Colonial America.

Historic Port of Falmouth

401 River Road, Falmouth, Virginia 22405

Located off River Road, this area is a wonderful place to enjoy the beauty of the Rappahannock River. The area is a great place to fish (VA fishing license required), and it is equipped with picnic areas.

Moncure Conway House

303 King Street, Falmouth, VA 22405

The stately Federal-period Moncure Conway House in Falmouth is one of Stafford's historic treasures. The home was associated earlier with the Vass and Beale families. It was the boyhood home of Moncure Daniel Conway, the South's most prominent abolitionist. During the Civil War it was used as a Union hospital. While this home is now privately-owned, you can drive by the historic site.

National Museum of the Marine Corps

18900 Richmond Highway, Triangle, VA 22172

A monument to honor, courage, and commitment, the museum is a lasting tribute to U.S. Marines — past, present, and future.

Patawomeck Museum and Cultural Center

638 Kings Highway, Fredericksburg, VA 22405

The Patawomeck Indian Tribe of Virginia is based in Stafford along the Potomac River, and is recognized as one of Virginia's 11 Native American Tribes. The Patawomeck Indian Tribal Center is the site of the Museum and Cultural Center, and includes an outdoor living history village and indigenous gardens, spread over 17 acres.

Shannon Air Museum

3380 Shannon Airport Circle, Fredericksburg, VA 22408

Shannon Air Museum offers a rare collection of vintage aircraft which were owned by one of the founders of Eastern Airlines, Sidney Shannon Sr.

Shelton Cottage of Falmouth

River Road, Falmouth, VA 22405

Along River Road stands a small cottage in contrast to Basil Gordon House and Moncure Conway House, representing what a colonial workingman might aspire to possess in his own right.

St. George's Episcopal Church

905 Princess Anne Street, Fredericksburg, VA 22401

For the 300 years of its existence, St. George's Church has played an active part in the community of Fredericksburg. George Washington and many of his family and friends attended services at St. George's and it served as a hospital during the Civil War.

Stafford Armed Services Memorial

1300 Courthouse Road, Stafford, VA 22554

For more than 200 years, residents of Stafford County have served honorably in our nation's armed forces to preserve freedom and democracy. The memorial is a fitting place for the public to honor their sacrifice.

Stafford Civil War Park

400 Mt. Hope Church Road, Stafford, VA 22554

This 41-acre park tells the story of the Army of the Potomac's Winter Encampment in 1863. More than 135,000 soldiers occupied Stafford while their new commander, General Joseph Hooker rebuilt his army. This critical time has been referred to in soldier's letters as "The Union Army's Valley Forge."

The Rowser Building

1739 Richmond Highway, Stafford, VA 22554

Originally built in 1939 by the Public Works Administration as the Stafford Training School (a term used in the South to differentiate a White high school from a Black high school). It was the only place where Black students could receive an education beyond the 7th grade. This building is now listed on the National Register of Historic Places and as a Virginia Landmark.

Trail to Freedom

Retrace the routes of freedom seekers through the area. A driving tour through Stafford County provides a stop-by-stop interpretation of the 10,000 former slaves who began their freedom journey in the spring of 1862.



OUTDOORS

THE GREAT OUTDOORS

Belmont-Ferry Farm Trail

401 River Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405

Enjoy a two mile hike through three public parks in southern Stafford County. Scenic beauty surrounds you as the path winds through the Historic Port of Falmouth.

Crow's Nest Natural Area Preserve

81 Raven Road, Stafford, VA 22554

A simply beautiful place, protecting approximately 3,000 acres. Enjoy 8 miles of hiking trails and a new kayak water trail.

Government Island

191 Coal Landing Road, Stafford, VA 22554

A Scenic Heritage Trail through a 17-acre early American sandstone quarry, a source of stone used to construct the U.S. Capitol and the White House.

Widewater State Park

101 Widewater State Park Road, Stafford, VA 22554

Cradled between the Potomac River and Aquia Creek, Widewater has always been an important access point to the waterways that developed our nation. The land has hosted commercial fishing, duck hunting, and an active port. Today the park is an important link to the resources of the Chesapeake Bay providing the public premier access to both the river and creek as well as canoe-kayak launches and hiking trails.


